Effective April 10th, 2017, ELA General Assignment Paras for Spanish are required to complete a proficiency exam hosted by Berlitz. The test has two parts, speaking and reading and the candidate must pass in order to be hired for the position. The cost of this test is \$70. Copy of your high school diploma or GED *and* SAT scores (within the last 5 years) of minimum 500+ in Math and 470+ in Reading.
