As a Housing Stability Specialist, you will:

- Manage a caseload of up to 30 pregnant or parenting youth.
- Guide participants from initial housing consultation through housing placement and up to six months of stabilization support.
- Build partnerships with landlords, property managers, and community organizations to increase housing opportunities.
- Assist participants with housing applications, budgeting, lease education, and tenant responsibilities.
- Connect families to rental assistance, utility assistance, employment resources, and other community services.
- Advocate for participants while collaborating with internal teams and community partners.
- Maintain accurate case documentation and service records.
- Coordinate referrals to Florence Crittenton's Supportive Family Services Program (SFSP) and other community resources.
- Represent Florence Crittenton Services at community meetings and outreach events.
- Provide transportation assistance to participants when appropriate and when a company vehicle is available.
